WHO? Painters, Renovation and Repair Contractors, Building Code Officials, Regulators, Residents, Parents, Landlords, Staff working with Contractors

Must work or live in the local area, be at least 18 years of age, and be available all day. Must understand and read English and be able to show State photo ID for proof of residence for EPA. Please note your photo will be taken - it is required for your Certification Certificate after passing exam.

- Lead-based paint renovation training for residents or service providers in your area:
 - Youth Build trainees or and other apprentice programs, profit or non-profit groups
 - Renovators, painters, window installers, housing maintenance staff, electricians, HVAC specialists, plumbers, floor finishers, as well as landlords performing any of same tasks
- Any worker who removes windows or disrupts more than 6 square feet of paint in pre-1978 homes, schools, daycare centers, even if vacant, must be in compliance.

- **It is the Law-- without training; you may face fines up to \$37,500 per day.**
- Protect yourself, your workers, customers, and your own children from serious health risks.
